Description	Recombinant <i>Lactococcus lactis</i> β -acetylglucosaminidase 73B produced by <i>Escherichia coli</i> , is an enzyme that is responsible for hydrolyzing the diacetylchitobiosyl unit in glycopeptides and glycoproteins with the (Man(GlcNAc)(2))Asn structure, releasing the intact oligosaccharide except for one <i>N</i> -acetyl-D-glucosamine residue that remains attached to the protein.
