<b>Description</b>	Lentinan-PEG-histidine, also termed His-lentinan, embodies a multifunctional conjugate where histidine residues are grafted onto lentinan's $\beta$ -1,3-1,6-glucan structure through PEG spacers. The formulation leverages lentinan's immunomodulation alongside DPPS-related fusogenic properties for combined therapeutic effects.
<b>Glycan Structure</b>	Its glycan structure is a $\beta$ -(1 $\rightarrow$ 3)-linked d-glucose backbone with $\beta$ -(1 $\rightarrow$ 6)-glucosyl side branches.
<b>Source</b>	Chemical synthesis
